Where are you located?



Camp Diamond is located in Highland Grove, Ontario only 2.5 hours from Toronto and Ottawa off Hwy 118 and 648. Less than 30 minutes from Bancroft and Haliburton and 45 minutes to Algonquin Park. We are close to emergency services but far enough away to enjoy the serenity of the Haliburton Highlands.

What qualifications do your staff have?

Staff who work at Camp Diamond have a vested interest in summer camp. They have prior experience working with children and enjoy the outdoors. All staff are certified in Standard First Aid and CPR C. In addition they must undergo a rigorous interview process, reference checks and have a clear criminal background check including a VSS search. Prior to campers arriving, all staff attend a two week orientation during which they practice risk management, review rules and regulations, and participate in leadership activities and team building.
